#### • THE COURSE •

All races are 2 miles. The course starts and finishes on grass in Hidden Valley Park. In between the terrain rolls over dirt trails and portions of asphalt. Spectators can easily view the first and last half-mile of the race.

Many of the races in this meet feature fields of over 200 runners! In the excitement we ask that coaches make every effort to keep themselves, their athletes, and spectators out of the way of competitors. This means staying off the course while races are underway.

**ATHLETES MUST WEAR THE CORRECT BIB NUMBER & CHIP!** Each athlete must be entered in the meet via the Athletic.net registration process. The assigned bib number is specific to the athlete.

Please bring problems with bib numbers and/or chips to the attention of the timer tent at the finish line.
