ATHLETE CONTRIBUTION EXPLANATION

The Campolindo High School Track & Field Program asks that each athlete contribute **\$100** to the team Associated Student Body Account to help cover the costs of seasonal expenses, including meet entry fees, administrative supplies, web site fees, team awards, equipment purchases and facility maintenance and improvement.

This contribution is in addition to the AUHSD sport participation fee charged to all athletes. The AUHSD sport participation fees are collected by the district, and used to cover district expenses for all sports, including coaching stipends, bus transportation, and district administrative costs. AUHSD sport participation fees are NOT distributed to the teams!

Therefore, this athlete contribution to our team account is essential for us to continue to provide the best possible practice and competition environment for the athletes!

If there is a financial hardship that prevents the athlete from providing this contribution, it should be brought to the attention of the coaches. A reduction or waiver of the fee is available to athletes with financial hardship.

- **Seiko Stopwatch and System SP12 printer. Total expense: \$360.00.**
- NEW Custom Screened Team Competition Uniforms: 130 Boys' sets, 100 Girls' sets (singlet/short). **Total expense: \$8,000.00.**
- 8 x UCS Spirit Pole Vault Poles: Approximately \$400.00 Each. **Total expense: \$3,200.00.**
- Hard Shell Indoor Shots: \$45.00 -4k Shot, \$50.00 5k Shot, \$55.00 -12lb Shot. **Total expense: \$300.00.**
- Megaphone: \$90.00 Each. **Total expense: \$90.00.**
- 6 x Medicine Balls: \$42.00 -5k Ball, \$34.00 -4k Ball, \$27.00 -3k Ball. **Total expense: \$206.00.**
- 5 x Ultrak 495 Stop Watch: \$37.00 Each. **Total expense: \$296.00.**

• **Aluminum Track Curbing.** Recommended by the National Federation, installation of an aluminum curb to the Campolindo facility is necessary to meet practical training needs as well as NHFS competition standards.

The custom fitted and installed aluminum curb prevents athletes from cutting inside lane one, as well as creates a boundary line for additional safety during training and competition. The curved sections are pre-bent to fit. Drain pads lift the curb 1/2" off the track surface for immediate drainage of water and debris. Special activities and vehicle access is accommodated by easily moving any curb section.

AAE Aluminum Outdoor Track Curbing and Installation = \$18,000.00
